## EMAILED TO ALL SWIM SCHOOL PARTICIPANTS

Hello! Welcome Back or Welcome to our YMCA Swim School!

## Please read the entire email as there are new and constantly updating information that must be adhered to when your swimmer comes to their lessons.

Your swimmer will need to bring with them to every class a bathing suit that fits appropriately, as well as a towel. There is an option of goggles, some do prefer but others do not, either is okay with us.

When arriving on pool deck, we can only allow 1 adult per swimmer. Meaning if you have 2 swimmers that are swimming back to back (e.g 3pm and 3:30pm) we can only have 1 adult on pool deck per swimmer as per Gov. Lamont's guidelines. I know this is a pain for many, but we do have Child Watch that is a free service for the ages of 8 weeks – 12 years old. If you need to do this, please make sure to schedule a drop off for FREE via our Motionvibe scheduling system.

Masks must be worn by all covering you and your swimmers nose and mouth while on pool deck. Your swimmer is asked to bring a plastic bag (sandwich zip lock works best) to put their mask in by pools edge. Once your swimmer is in their lesson they will be asked to remove their mask and do their lesson, once the lesson is over, prior to leaving their class, they will be asked to put it back on.

During our lesson period, all caregivers are asked to sit in a red box on pool deck. These boxes are placed all over the pool deck, 6ft+ apart. We do recommend sitting away from your swimmers lesson as to not distract them or interrupt the lesson itself. If the instructor needs your assistance with a bathroom break or an issue they will call you over to assist.

Once the lesson is over, you are more than welcome to use our Universal Locker rooms located on the left hand side of our wet hallway (there are 4) as well as our Male and Female locker rooms located on the right side of the wet hallway. Please note, those older than 5 years old can not be in the opposite sex locker room. Showers as well as changing areas are available for use at this time. We also have lockers for day use as well as rental use if you are interested. These are located in our locker rooms as well as outside of our Universal Locker rooms.

Make up classes are offered ONLY when a guardian EMAILS prior to missing a program class. From there I will set up a make up class the same week or the week after. Credits will ONLY be given if we have to cancel a program class that can not be made up. All credits will be listed on your YMCA account for future use on any program. No refunds will be given after the first class.

We are most certainly looking forward to getting back to our somewhat normal looking swim lesson program!
