

Riverbrook Robins  
Participant Equipment Storage Policy  
Updated 4/1/24

Participants may leave one set of personal shooting equipment in the designated area in the Y gym storage under the following conditions:

-The Riverbrook YMCA is not liable for the damage to, or loss of, equipment left at the YMCA. Equipment is left at the owner's risk.

-Personal equipment includes: Bow, Arrows, Bow accessories (Sight, Stabilizers, V-/sidebars, plungers, clickers), Shooting equipment (armguard, finger tab, shooting glove, mechanical release, chest protector, quiver, bow stand). **All equipment MUST be in a single, labeled case secured with a lock.**

-Equipment will be accessible during class times. Anyone dropping off or taking equipment must sign it in or out, witnessed by Y Archery staff. Access to equipment outside of class times, including retrieval, must be arranged with the Riverbrook Y Archery or Sports Directors.

-Owners must be registered for Riverbrook Y Archery programming to store equipment. Owners will be contacted at the start of any session they are not registered to pick up their equipment. Equipment left for three consecutive sessions without contact from the owner will be considered abandoned.
