We have news to share in respect to the 50M pool. We shared with you that engineers were on site to conduct a rebar scan and core tests. The results did indicate small voids under the pool. This is good news, as the voids could have been more catastrophic. Additionally, there was no movement to the pool deck. The engineers will use these results to determine the best plan of action and timeline. We do anticipate the 50M pool will reopen in mid-November.

We have begun conversations with environmental engineers who will play a vital role in our recovery efforts. Together, we will develop a comprehensive flood mitigation plan for our 16-acre campus. This will allow us to live in harmony with the river and decrease the impact of any future disasters. In doing this, it affirms our commitment to be the best steward of your generous gifts.

Our staff team has been working tirelessly to ensure that all other business operations continue as normal and I grow prouder each day with their resilience and love they have for our Y and you. Every day, our Y strengthens communities for kids, adults, seniors and families with programs that protect, teach, connect, heal, nourish and encourage.
